Congratulations! You are now a senior and will be featured in the 2017-18 yearbook with a larger, formal portrait in the senior section. Photos are free but must be taken by Larson Brothers Photography. Other photos cannot be used.

Please keep in mind, seniors *must* be in Central Unified School District dress code to take their photo. Yearbook cannot publish any photos which violate this policy, so if you arrive to the studio out of dress code, you will have to reschedule.

Dress Code Requirements:

Ladies:

- Tops *must have 2 inch straps (minimum) or sleeves.*
- No low cut or sheer garments.

Gentlemen:

- You must *wear a collared shirt and tie.*
- Vests, suit jackets, letterman jackets and bow ties are permitted.

All Students:

- No hats or sunglasses allowed.
- No visible body *piercing* or *tattoos* allowed. Ear piercings are permitted.
- Hair cannot be an *unnatural color* or *cut in an extreme manner.*
- Clothing must be free of writing or images conveying *inappropriate* or *offensive messages* including: gangs, sex, drugs, alcohol as well as racial, religious, political, ability, gender and sexual-orientation discrimination.

Important Portrait Deadlines:

- Last day to schedule a studio appointment is September 1st.
- Big summer plans? Schedule early to get the best dates! Appointments are offered first come, first serve.
- Can't go to the studio? Email Yearbook Adviser Ms. Kaspian to schedule an on-campus make-up photo.
- Check the school website for updates and to check your photo for errors around the end of October.
